On February 2, 1982, the Commission scheduled a hearing on an appeal filed by Charles T. Howard to a decision by the Brewster Historic District Committee which had approved a steel building for Gerald B. Evans and Chester C. Evans for property located at Underpass Road in Brewster, Massachusetts.

Present were: Mr. Brown, Orleans, Mr. Ivers, Brewster, Mr. Hanger, Dennis, Mr. Long, Yarmouth, Mr. MacSwan, Barnstable, Mr. Sutton, Sandwich and James R. Wilson, Commission Counsel

Mr. MacSwan called the hearing to order at 2:30 P. M. and Attorney Wilson read to the Commission a letter which he had received from the Petitioner dated January 21, 1982 in which Mr. Howard stated that he wished to have his appeal petition withdrawn. Mr. Wilson stated that the reason given was that Mr. Howard did not wish to impose any further financial hardship on his neighbor.

In view of the letter and there being no one appearing at the Commission hearing in behalf of Mr. Howard, it was voted unanimously to affirm the decision of the Brewster Committee.
