On Tuesday, October 7, 1986 the Commission held a hearing on Appeal #86-19 filed by Neal and Gail Bissett seeking review of the Sandwich Historic District Committee's denial of a Certificate of Appropriateness for an addition to a motel located at 96 Route 6A, Sandwich, Massachusetts.

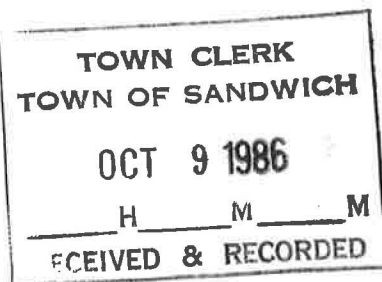
Present were: Mr. Smith, Yarmouth; Mrs. Stout, Dennis; Mr. Shay, Brewster; Mr. Freeman, Barnstable; Mr. White, Sandwich; Mr. Wilson, Commission Counsel. The applicants were not present.

The chairman called the hearing to order at 8:23 P.M., eight minutes after the appointed time for the hearing, and read the appeal petition into the record. It was noted that the applicants were not present, and Mr. Wilson pointed out that the appeal appeared to have been late filed.

The decision of the Sandwich Committee had been filed with the Town Clerk on August 28, 1986 and the appeal filed with the Commission on September 11, 1986, three days beyond the ten-day appeal period.

After lengthy discussion by the Commissioners, the Commission voted to deny the appeal based upon its late filing, and therefore the decision of the local Committee denying a Certificate of Appropriateness is affirmed.

Any person aggrieved by this decision has a right to appeal to the Barnstable District Court within 20 days of the filing of this decision with the Sandwich Town Clerk.
