OLD KING'S HIGHWAY REGIONAL HISTORIC
DISTRICT COMMITTEE FOR THE TOWN OF
BREWSTER

On Tuesday, April 29, 1986 the Commission held a hearing on Appeal 86-5 filed by Rosalie Nelson and Patricia C. Cross seeking review of the decision by the Brewster Historic District Committee which had granted a Certificate of Appropriateness to Marc Cadarette for a new dwelling to be located at 424 Main Street, West Brewster, Massachusetts.

Present were: Mr. MacSwan, Barnstable; Mr. Blaisdell, Sandwich; Mrs. Stout, Dennis; Mr. Smith, Yarmouth; Mrs. Reis, Brewster; Marc Cadarette, the applicant, and Mr. Wilson, Commission Counsel.

The hearing was called to order at the scheduled time of 7:30 P.M. and it was noted that the appellants were not present.

After a brief discussion the Commission decided to proceed with the hearing. Mrs. Reis, speaking on behalf of the Brewster Committee, described the position of the Committee in approving the proposed dwelling. She indicated that in the opinion of the Committee the building would be compatible with the neighborhood. There being no opposition to the Brewster Committee's decision the Commission made the following finding and determination.

That there was sufficient evidence to substantiate the granting of a Certificate of Appropriateness, and, therefore, the decision of the Brewster Committee is hereby affirmed.

Any person aggrieved by this decision has a right to appeal to the Orleans District Court within 20 days of the filing of this decision with the Brewster Town Clerk.
