OLD KING'S HIGHWAY REGIONAL HISTORIC
DISTRICT COMMITTEE FOR THE TOWN OF
BREWSTER

On Tuesday, June 30, 1987 the Commission held a hearing on Appeal #87-11 filed by Christopher and Krista Diego seeking review of a decision by the Brewster Historic District Committee which had conditioned the construction of an outside staircase to steel on a building located at Route 6A, Brewster, Massachusetts.

Present were Barbara Hart, Dennis; John Blaisdell, Sandwich; Milton Smith, Yarmouth; Michael Shay, Brewster; Peter Freeman, Barnstable; Robert G. Brown, Commission Counsel; Mr. Diego, Applicant.

The Committee's decision had been filed with the Town Clerk on May 26, 1987, and the appeal entered with the Commission on May 29, 1987 within the ten day appeal period. The Applicants waived the 30 day appeal period to facilitate hearing the matter on June 30, 1987.

Mr. Diego addressed the Commission and asked that Mr. Shay be allowed to speak. Michael Shay addressed the Commission and said that the Brewster Committee had voted, at its meeting of June 15, 1987, to ask that this matter be remanded to the Brewster Historic District Committee for further discussion. The Applicant stated that he was in agreement with this.

After brief discussion, the Commission made the following determination.

1. That the matter be remanded to the Brewster Committee for further discussion and that this determination was not to be interpreted as a determination that the Brewster Committee acted in an arbitrary, capricious and erroneous manner in placing the restriction on the Applicants' project. 4-0-1

Any person aggrieved by this decision has a right to appeal to the District Court Department, Orleans Division, within 20 days of the filing of this decision with the Brewster Town Clerk.
