OLD KING'S HIGHWAY REGIONAL HISTORIC
DISTRICT COMMITTEE FOR THE TOWN OF
SANDWICH

On Tuesday, October 3, 2000 the Commission cancelled the hearings on Appeals #2000-18 & #2000-19 filed by the Dockmejian Realty Trust, seeking review of the decisions by the Sandwich Historic District Committee denying a Certificate of Appropriateness for signs to be located at 95 Tupper Road, Sandwich, Massachusetts.

Present were Dorothy Stahley, Barnstable; Paul White, Sandwich; Deborah Gray, Yarmouth; Roy Robinson, Brewster; Elizabeth Wilcox, Dennis; Robert G. Brown, Commission Counsel.

The Committee's decision was filed with the Town Clerk on August 23, 2000. The appeal was entered with the Commission on August 24, 2000, within the 10 day appeal period.

IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE MATTER HAD BEEN RESOLVED AT THE LOCAL SANDWICH TOWN COMMITTEE LEVEL AND THAT A SIGN DESIGN ACCEPTABLE TO THE PARTIES HAD BEEN APPROVED.

The appeal hearings were cancelled.
