On February 8, 2002 the Commission received an appeal filed by Brenda Tri and Victor Cillis (Appeal #2002-2) seeking review of a decision by the Barnstable Historic District Committee which had denied a Certificate for Demolition and Certificate of Appropriateness for a property located at 2051 Main Street, West Barnstable, Massachusetts.

The Committee's decision was filed with the Town Clerk on January 31, 2002. The appeal was entered with the Commission on February 8, 2002, within the 10 day appeal period.

On May 20, 2002, while the appeal was pending, the Applicants submitted a written withdrawal and the appeal was abandoned.


Dear Mr. Wilson:
