**Old King's Highway Regional Historic
District Committee For the Town of
Barnstable**

On Tuesday, July 15, 2003 the Commission held a hearing on Appeal #2003-6 filed by Light House Construction Company, seeking reversal of a decision by the Barnstable Historic District Committee denying a Certificate of Appropriateness for red cedar roofing shingles, replacement of rotted chimney and replacement of front door to a dwelling located at 2412 Meeting House Way, West Barnstable, Massachusetts.

Present were Jeffery Wilson, Barnstable; Jonathan Shaw, Sandwich; Deborah Gray, Yarmouth; Roy Robinson, Brewster; Peter Lomenzo, Dennis; James R. Wilson, Commission Counsel.

The Committee's decision was filed with the Town Clerk on June 12, 2003. The appeal was entered with the Commission on June 19, 2003, within the 10-day appeal period.

The Appellant's Presentation:

The hearing was called at 7:45 PM as advertised and again at 8:00 PM. No one responded to the call.

The Town Committee's Presentation:

Jeffery Wilson addressed the Commission on behalf of the Barnstable Town Committee. He stated that the Committee had properly denied the application.

Discussion:

The members of the Commission reviewed the record and denied the appeal.

Findings:

The Commission found as follows:

That the decision of the Barnstable Town Committee should be affirmed

Determination:

As to Appeal #2003-6, the appeal is denied and decision of the Barnstable Committee is affirmed (4-0-1).

Any person aggrieved by this decision has a right to appeal to the District Court Department, Barnstable Division, within 20 days of the filing of this decision with the Barnstable Town Clerk.
