Gentlemen:

Following receipt of your letter dated July 25, 1975 the question of an appeal to the Old King's Highway Regional Historic District Commission on a decision by the Town of Brewster Committee was reviewed by the Commission Members and the Commission Attorney, James R. Wilson at the Commission meeting of August 4, 1975.

Chapter 470, Section 11 of the Acts of 1973, (O.K.H.R.H.D.C.) states: "any person aggrieved by the determination of the committee... may within 20 days, after the filing of a notice of such determination with the Town Clerk ... appeal to the Commission".

It is the opinion of the members of the Commission who attended the meeting of August 4, 1975 and also the opinion of the Commission's attorney that you failed to perfect your appeal in that situation as the time for an appeal expired on July 12, 1975.

Obviously, your appeal was not perfected and as such we will be unable to entertain said appeal.
