

Appeal #75 - 7 (Sandwich)

The appeal of Mrs. Betty Bridges, trustee, from the decision of the Sandwich Historic District Committee granting a certificate of appropriateness to Stanley C. Hills for the erection of a windmill for generating electric power was heard. Mr. Hanger noted that prior to the hearing he had inspected the proposed site for the windmill on a ridge in the vicinity of Sandy Neck Road. Technical data, picture and sketches of the windmill and a map of its proposed location were submitted and examined. Mrs. Bridges presented here arguments in opposition and Mr. Hills his arguments in support of the proposed structure. Mr. Davis, of Barnstable spoke in support of Mr. Hills' project. Mr. Bridges joined in the discussion. After a general discussion among the commission a vote was taken. Messrs. Gregory, MacSwan and Hock-enbury and Ms. Vaughn voted to affirm the action of the Sandwich Committee in granting the certificate to Mr. Hills and Messrs. Hanger and Comeau voted to the contrary. Mr. Bourne, Sandwich chairman, abstained from voting but participated in the discussion.
