Dear Mr. Haguire:

This is to advise you that after hearing and review on your appeal to the Regional Commission of the decision by the Brewster Town Committee, denying a Certificate of Appropriateness for Lot 4, Thousand Oaks Drive in Brewster, the Commission by a 5 - 0 - 1 vote has annuled the decision of the Brewster Committee and approved your Certificate of Appropriateness.

At the hearing it became apparent that the house that you wish to place upon lot 4 was significantly different from that one approved for lot 3 so as to be appropriate to the area, and that the Brewster Committee erred in denying your application. The Commission found that the colors for roofing, doors, siding, and overall structural arrangements were significantly distinctive. Further, the Commission discovered, contrary to the record of the local Committee hearing, that the elevations of lots 3 and 4 varied to an extent of nearly 18 feet.

You are reminded that any person aggrieved by this decision will have a right of appeal to the Second District Court of Bernstable within 20 days of the filing of this decision with the Town Clerk.
