Re: Appeal of Brewster Town Committee regarding construction of deck and sliding door on hearing held on November 22, 1976.

Dear Mr. Jones:

I regret to advise you that the above entitled appeal was received by the Commission on December 6, 1976, thirteen days after the decision was filed with the Town Clerk. Under Chapter 470 of the Acts of 1973, as amended, appeals of local town decisions must be filed within ten days of the date of the filing of the decision with the local Town Clerk. Additionally, your appeal was defective in that it failed to comply with the provisions of Article III, section 6 which requires that a copy of the Town Committee decision must be filed with the appeal petition and further that a copy of the appeal must be given to the Town Clerk and Town Committee.

I enclose for your reference a copy of the District Act as amended and the rules and regulations which are also available at the Brewster Town Hall.

The Regional Historic District Commission at their monthly meeting held on Tuesday, December 7, 1976, voted to deny your appeal based upon the above stated reasons and directed that I forward this notice to you and to the Town Clerk and Town Committee so as to establish an appeal period in the event you wish to seek judicial review in the District Court.
