DECISION ON APPEAL TO

A hearing was held on May 17, 1977 by the above Commission on the appeal by Milton Schwartz and others from the decision of the Town of Sandwich Historic District Committee granting a certificate of appropriateness to Robert Lucas for the construction of a dwelling house at the corner of Water and School Streets in the town of Sandwich.

It appearing that a revised building plan was in preparation and that the controversy might be amicably resolved and appellants Milton Schwartz and Grattan Gill being present on behalf of all appellants and Robert W. Bridges being present on behalf of appellee Robert Lucas and approving, this Commission, Mr. Bourne abstaining, unanimously voted/to annul the granting of the certificate of appropriateness issued by the Sandwich Town Committee to Robert Lucas and to remand the matter to the Sandwich Committee for consideration and action upon such revised plan.
