## OLD KING'S HIGHWAY REGIONAL HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMITTEE FOR THE TOWN OF YARMOUTH

On Tuesday, June 22, 1993 the Commission held a hearing on Appeal #93-8 filed by Stuart K. Wood and Edith B. Wood seeking review of a decision by the Yarmouth Historic District Committee which had denied a Certificate of Exemption for alterations to a house located at 390 Main Street, Yarmouthport, Massachusetts.

Present were Pat Rothermel, Dennis; Patricia Bush, Brewster; Peter Freeman, Barnstable; David Moeller, Yarmouth; Christopher Miner, Orleans; Steve Carmel, Sandwich; Robert G. Brown, Commission Counsel; Stuart K. Wood and Edith B. Wood, Appellants; and many interested members of the public.

The Committee's decision had been filed with the Town Clerk on May 13, 1993, and the appeal entered with the Commission on May 18, 1993, within the 10 day appeal period. The 30 day determination period was waived by agreement.

### THE APPELLANT'S PRESENTATION:

Stuart K. Wood, Appellant, addressed the Commission in favor of the appeal. He stated that he had applied for a Certificate of Exemption to shingle the front of his house as well as the East and West sides. He said that he was willing to shingle only the sides of the house and leave the front clapboard but the Yarmouth Committee was negative to that idea. He stated that he would be conforming to the Guidelines of the Commission as set forth in the December 1983 Bulletin of the Commission and displayed photographs of the neighborhood within two miles of his home.
